Library Profile

Shri Mailaraligeshwar Post Graduate College was established by the Dr Baba Saheb Ambedkar Vidya Vardhaka Sangh's at Shorapur in 2010-11. The Founder Secretary of DBSAVV Sangh's **Late Sri Bagappa Billav** was a visionary. He was aptly called as **Sagar Nadin Shikshan Shilpi of Hyderabad Karnataka Region & truly a great educationist** who brought revolutionary progress in educationally backward region of Hyderabad Karnataka. He had conceptualized the establishment of an institution of higher education at Shorapur, Shahapur, Devadurga and Kalaburagi and more than 35 Educational Institutions started. Our college is affiliated to Raichur University, Raichur and located at Shorapur Taluka, Yadagir District, Karnataka State. The library collection 10 thousands includes general Reference books, Text books, Donated Books, CD's, Periodicals, Bound Volumes of the journals etc. It has different sections namely, Reference Section, Current affairs section, PG section and Subject reference section, Stack section, e-Resource Centre, Circulation section, processing section etc. The IKC is well equipped with 10 computers and other IT related facilities. Out of these about 08 systems with Internet facility for students to use the Internet and e-resources in the e-Resources Centre. Shri Mailaraligeshwar Post Graduate College library has adopted some of the best practices which can be highlighted as below :

- ❖ **Journals and Magazines Facility:** Our College Library subscribing more than 15 Journals and Magazines. Some are Weekly, Monthly and Quarterly also. Journals like a University News, Seminar, Teachers Movement, Yojana, Hosatu, Janapada.
- ❖ **Orientation Programme :** The librarian has been conducting orientation programme to the new students admitted every academic year both for PG students separately. The orientation programme includes the facilities and services available in the library , do's and don't, collection, Rules and regulations OPAC search, e-resources etc. Orientation will be arranged even for the newly joined Faculty members. This helps them to get acquainted with the library resources.
- ❖ **Internet and Wi-Fi facility :** All the 10 systems in the e-resource centre having internet connectivity with 100 mbps speed. Along with this the whole library is having Wi-Fi connectivity. Students and faculty members can make use of internet free of cost.
- ❖ **Annual best library user award:** Based on the registers and statistics maintained in the library and the observations of the library staff every year one students is given annual best library user award. The main objective of this practice is to develop library culture among students.
- ❖ **User feedback :** User feedback is collected on all aspects of the library facilities and services. Library maintains a Log Book and Suggestion box which is periodically checked in order to

ensure the effective utilization of library services. Feedback of library services is obtained in Student Council meetings and the same is shared with the librarians for further action. Now it is also started collecting the feedback from the participants of workshops and training programs. This will help the library staff to improve the services.

- ❖ **Organizing book exhibition** : Library is organizing book exhibition by the dealers every year.
- ❖ **Organizing various competitions** : On some special occasions like Librarian's day organizing various competitions for the users. The competitions like memory game, article browsing, pick and search, treasure hunt, quiz etc. The main purpose of all these competitions is to make aware of the resources available in the library. So that increases the use of library resources.
- ❖ **Current content display** : Content pages of the journals will be scanned and uploaded in digital display board.
- ❖ **New arrival notifications** : Other than New arrival books display, List of new arrivals will be sent to all the departments through departmental e-mail fortnightly.
- ❖ **E-mail reminders** : Circulation due reminders will be sent to the students as well as faculty members everyday through e-mail.
- ❖ **Digitization** : Previous years Question papers were scanned and uploaded in the software for students benefit.
- ❖ **Institutional repository** : Institution is taken for Institutional repository with Faculty publications and question papers and project reports are in developing stage.
